ORDINANCE NO. 66 / 2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIAL(S) TO: PURCHASE AND/OR LEASE VARIOUS TITLED VEHICLES; ADVERTISE, RECEIVE BIDS, AWARD, AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR THOSE PURCHASES AND ANY PROJECTS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT A THAT EXCEED ANY APPLICABLE DOLLAR AMOUNT THRESHOLD(S); ALTERNATIVELY ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASES AND PROJECTS PURSUANT TO ANY PROCUREMENT PROCESS AUTHORIZED BY LAW; ENTER INTO ALL PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACTS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT A; WAIVES THE INFORMAL RESOLUTION REQUIREMENTS OF CANTON CODIFIED ORDINANCE 105.09 FOR PURCHASES APPROVED THROUGH THIS ORDINANCE; AMENDING THE 2020 FINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE; AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANTON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The appropriate official(s), on behalf of the city of Canton, is authorized to purchase and/or lease the titled vehicles described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, including all necessary equipment and components, in accordance with Section 105.08 of the Canton Codified Ordinances.

Section 2. The appropriate official(s), on behalf of the city of Canton, is further authorized to advertise, receive bids, award, and enter into contract for the purchases and projects described in Exhibit A that exceed any applicable dollar amount threshold(s).

Section 3. The appropriate official(s), on behalf of the city of Canton, is authorized to alternatively enter into contract for the purchases and projects described in Section 2 via any procurement process authorized by law.

Section 4. The appropriate official(s), on behalf of the city of Canton, is authorized to enter into all professional services contracts described in Exhibit A.

Section 5. Council waives the informal resolution requirements of Canton Codified Ordinance 105.09 for purchases approved through this ordinance.

Section 6. The 2020 final appropriation ordinance, which was passed as companion legislation is amended by making the following supplemental appropriations:

Section 7. The Auditor is authorized and directed to draw his warrants upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.


Section 8. The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Majority Leader, to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 9. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the citizens of the city of Canton; the emergency being to avoid unnecessary delay in the foregoing purchases for the efficient operation of various departments of the city of Canton. And provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected and/or appointed members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



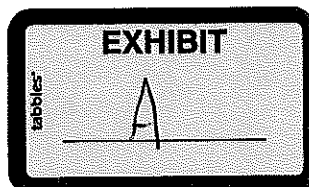
